## January 2016

During January of 2016 the Candia Recycling Center land-filled **55.46** tons of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW). There was also **18.68** tons of C&D debris disposed of January of 2016. This gave a total of **74.14** tons of waste processed during January 2016.

## **Recyclables**

Mix Paper - 11 bales = 17,913 lbs. = 8.95 tons.

<u>Cardboard</u> - 8 bales = 11,361 lbs. = 5.68 tons.

#1 - #7 plastics -3 bales = 3548 = 1.77 tons

<u>Tin cans</u> – **3** bales =**3894** lbs. = **1.95** tons.

Alum. Cans - 2 bales = 1593 lbs. = .80 tons.

#2 natural plastic – 1 bale = 686 lbs. = .34 tons.

<u>Glass-</u> 1 load = **10.13** tons

There were **28** bales of recyclables created which weighed **38,995** lbs. = **19.50** tons. There was also 1 load of glass sent out which weighed **10.13** tons. This gives us a total of **29.63** tons recycled during January 2016.


