The Candia Recycling Center Land-filled **71.48** tons of Municipal Solid waste (MSW) during May 2017. The Candia Recycling Center also sent out for recycling **52.20** tons of C&D debris during May 2017. The total amount of waste processed during May of 2017 is **123.60** tons.

Recyclables

Mixed Paper – 7 bales = **11,569** lbs. = **5.78** tons

Cardboard – 7 bales = **10,270** lbs. = **5.14** tons

#1-#7 plastics – 5 bales = **6107** lbs. = **3.05** tons

Tin Cans – 3 bales = **4188** lbs. = **2.07** tons

Aluminum Cans – 3 bales = **2387** lbs. = **1.14** tons

Glass - 1 load = **20,680** lbs. = **10.34** tons

26 bales created in May 2017 equals **34,521** lbs or **17.26** tons of recyclables, with a grand total **27.60** tons of material recycled.

On 5/5 there was **2520** lbs. of high grade dirty aluminum was marketed that generated **\$529** in revenue.

On 5/11 there was **6.30** tons of Cast Iron & #1 steel marketed which generated **\$675** in revenue.

On 5/19 two loads of Light iron were marketed with a total combined weight of **18.29** tons which generated **\$1469** in revenue.

On 5/30 there was **10.59** tons of Steel/Tin cans marketed which generated **\$1739** in revenue.

There was **\$4,412** in revenue generated during May of 2017.

June 2017

The Candia Recycling Center land-filled **64.24** tons of MSW (Municipal Solid waste) during June of 2017. The Candia recycling center sent out **62.80** tons of C&D debris to a C&D recycling center. There was a total of **127.04** tons of waste processed during June of 2017.

Recyclables

Mix Paper – 14 bales = **20,280** lbs. = **10.14** ton

Cardboard – 10 bales = **14060** lbs. = **7.03** ton

#1-#7 plastics = 4 bales = **4799** lbs. = **2.40** ton

Aluminum cans - 1 bale = **914** lbs. = **.46** ton

2 natural plastics – 1 bale = **956** lbs. = **.48** ton

Electronics – 1 haul = **6220** lbs. = **3.11** ton

There were **30** bales created during June 2017 that weighed **41,009** lbs. = **20.50** tons, including the electronics there was **47,229** lbs or **23.61** tons recycled during June 2017.

On 6/26 there was **10.05** tons of cardboard and **12.82** tons of mixed paper marketed which generated **\$1562.90** in revenue.

On 6/29 there was **19,500** lbs of #1-#7 plastics marketed that generated approx. **\$390** in revenue.

The CRC generated approx. **\$1952.90** in revenue during June 2017.
