## TOWN OF CANDIA

### Mosquito Control

The Mosquito Control program begins the week of April 12, 2010 in the Town of Candia. Crews will begin by checking Town owned swamps, marshes, woodland pools, ditches, storm drains and other shallow, stagnant water for mosquito larvae. Residents who would like to have their stagnant water checked for mosquitoes need to call **964-8400** or email **Info@DragonMosquito.com**. When mosquitoes are found, the following insecticides may be used: VectoBac (*Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis*), Altosid (methoprene), Agnique MMF (poly-isooctadecyl-hydroxyl), Mosquito Larvicide GB-1111 (aliphatic petroleum hydrocarbons) or BVA 2 Mosquito Larvicide Oil (highly refined petroleum distillate).

If Eastern Equine Encephalitis (EEE) or West Nile Virus (WNV) is found in or near Candia, then emergency adulticiding may be done at the following locations: Henry W Moore School, Moore Park, CYAA Fields, and the Town Forest. One of the following pesticides may be used: Permanone (permethrin), Flit (permethrin), Bifen I/T (bifenthrin), Wisdom TC Flowable (bifenthrin), Cross Check Plus (bifenthrin), Mavrik Perimeter (tau-fluvalinate), or Suspend SC (deltamethrin). A truck mounted sprayer could also be used to disperse Anvil (sumithrin) or Zenivex (etofenprox) along roadways. It is not possible to predict if emergency spraying will be necessary. The Board of Selectmen and the Health Officer, in consultation with Dragon Mosquito Control, will decide if adulticiding should be utilized. The spray schedule is based upon mosquito surveillance data, disease test results and weather conditions. Further communication will be given if emergency spraying is going to take place. Residents who do not want their property sprayed in the event of emergency road spraying, must contact Dragon Mosquito Control in writing at **P.O. Box 46, Stratham, NH 03885**. Be sure to include your name, physical address, phone number, and a description of your property with boundaries.
