#### Moore Park

The park continues to be used on a daily basis. The fence defining the front ballfield has been removed and the field mowed. I'm pricing out lime to be applied to the field before the soccer season starts. Volunteers are being recruited for planned maintenance activities this month. Matt Hawes hopes to be finished with the Eagle Scout sign project before Old Home Day. I'm working with the Old Home Day committee to help them plan the event activities that will take place in the park.

### Skateboard Park

The new structures installed in the skateboard park have had some equipment failures and I'm working with the vendor and the donors to expedite the repairs.
