On 10/27 there was mixed load of non-ferrous metals marketed, **2,297** lbs. generated **\$1148** in revenue

On 10/28 a combination load of Mix Paper and Cardboard was marketed, 13.13 tons of Mix Paper = \$459 & 8.97 tons of cardboard generated \$717 in revenue.
