Beginning in the spring of 2018, a Truck Committee within the Fire Department developed specifications and evaluated bids for the replacement of Engine 2. At this time the Committee recommends, and I agree, that the Town of Candia purchase the replacement engine, manufactured by Pierce Manufacturing Company, from Minuteman Fire & Rescue Apparatus, Inc. Attached to this letter is Minuteman's bid.

For this purchase I ask that the Selectmen create a warrant article for consideration by Candia voters at the 2020 Town Meeting. Partial funding can be from funds in the Fire Apparatus Capital Reserve Fund with the remaining funding method being at the discretion of the Selectmen.

Currier Road Warrant Article - 2020

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00)** for the southeast portion of Currier Road, this will be the first phase of a two year project. Said funds to be expended under the direction of the Board of Selectmen.

Healey Road Warrant Article - 2020

To see if the town will raise and appropriate the sum of **One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars** (150,000.00) for the first phase of Healey Road reconstruction, this will be the first phase of a two year project. Said funds to be expended under the direction of the Board of Selectmen.

Corporal Rick Langlois' commitment to the Town shows as he has been with the Candia Police Department since July 2000. He is the Departments firearms instructor and is the lead Field Training Officer. Corporal Rick Langlois has done well balancing duties as a supervisor and as the lead training officer. He has been instrumental in training the new officers, and the officers have told me that he is doing a great job. In January 2019, Corporal Langlois completed a leadership class, and plans on attending other classes. Based on seniority, merit, and work performance, I recommend that Candia Police Corporal Richard Langlois be promoted to the rank of Lieutenant effective immediately. I would suggest he start *at Grade 9, Step 12 \$33.41hr*.
