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Dear Attorney Courtney

Re: Town of Candia, NH Jane Drive Tree.

We have been notified by your client, Town of Candia NH that they will be holding a town meeting on December 23, 2019 to declare a small fruit tree on our property located at 14 Jane Drive a public nuisance.

- Please advise your client to advise us of the outcome of this town meeting in writing immediately after it is completed.
- As you know, RSA 231:146 allows us to appeal the town decision within 30 days to the Superior Court and we fully intend to do so. Please advise your client that they must allow time for this to occur and for the Superior court to hand out a judgement.
- As you know, RSA 231:145 states that a tree needs to be dead or diseased to be declared a nuisance. The tree in question is young, healthy & vibrant. We have enclosed a picture so you can see for yourself.
- The Town of Candia by it's own admission never got a deed for Jane Drive and therefore does not have the authority to dictate to the abutters what the abutters may or may not do on their own private property. This was stated and recorded in the selectman's public meeting minutes of 11/25/2019.
- RSA 231:150 provides that "shade and fruit trees that have been set out or marked by the abutting owners....and young trees standing at a proper distance from the highway and from each other, shall be preserved, as well as banks and hedges of bushes that serve as a protection of the highway, or that add beauty of the roadside."
- Please advise Town of Candia Selectman Brien Brock that he must abstain from all matters regarding the Jane Drive tree because he is a relative of Dustin Heiberg.
- We allege upon information and belief and it is our opinion that Road Agent Lewis has told Jennifer Heiberg and Heidi Kroll that he receives a substantial amount of money each and every year from the Deerfield Fair for work performed. Dennis Lewis has told Jennifer Heiberg that the residence of 33 Jane Drive have been complaining about the tree. Jenny Tyler resides at 33 Jane Drive and is the Treasurer of the Candia Agricultural Commission and her partner, Felix Gardner also resides at 33 Jane Drive. Felix Gardner is on the Deerfield Fair advisory board. Felix has told both Dustin and Jennifer Heiberg "I'm on the Deerfield Fair advisory board. The Deerfield Fair pays Dennis Lewis a lot of money each year. If Dennis Lewis does not start helping me out, I will pull his Deerfield Fair business." Dennis Lewis also confirmed to Jennifer Heiberg that he received a complaint from the residence of 32 Jane Drive. Valerie Watmough resides at 32 Jane Drive. Her ex-husband, David Watmough is also a Deerfield Fair Advisory board member. Please see attached ISR form listing the Deerfield Fair Advisory board members. It is the Selectman's duty to investigate the conflict of interest that potentially exists.
- It is our opinion that road agent Lewis's 3 year obsession with our small fruit tree growing on a cul-de-sac is quite peculiar. He is constantly scrutinizing our property for reasons only he knows.

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 As a compromise, if the Town of Candia, NH wants to hire a professional tree spade service and bear all expenses and liability to move the tree to a different location on our property, we would be open to this. As long as the tree is dormant so not to sustain damage. The tree has a 5 ¾ inch diameter and is approximately 15 feet tall if the town wishes to gather quotes.


