A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE VETERANS TAX CREDIT AND THE IMPACT OF INFLATION ON ITS VALUE

- 1. 1990 Town Meeting adopts Article 16 authorizing \$100 Veterans Tax Credit
- 2. 2003 Town Meeting adopts Article 18 authorizing \$300 Veterans Tax Credit
- 3. According to a Google search, the purchasing power of \$300 in 2003 is equilivent to \$424.37 in 2020:

In other words, \$300 in 2003 is equivalent in purchasing power to about \$424.37 in 2020, a difference of \$124.37 over 17 years.
