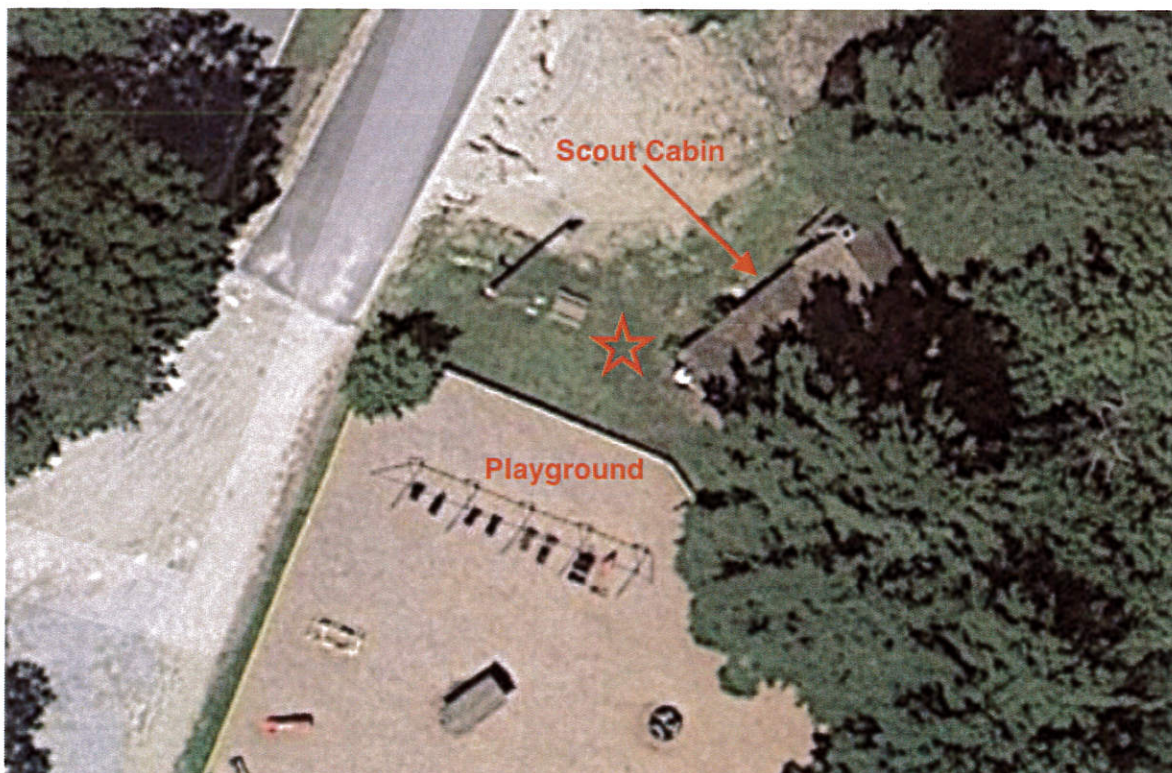

Linda,

When David Scott and I presented the Candia-Raymond project at the Selectmen's meeting on June 28, the traffic control was presented as one lane of alternating two-way traffic controlled by signals in phase 1 and two lanes of traffic in each direction in Phase 2. As we moved forward with this traffic control we realized that it would make more sense to have both phases be one lane of alternating two-way traffic to minimize the taper rates of the barrier and lane stripping which results in a smaller traffic control area. The time frame to complete the work in each phase has not changed and neither has the completion date of the project. The only change is that in phase 2 there will be a signal in place to control the traffic. I have included both a deck section and plan view of the updated traffic control.
