RE: Premium Pay Eligibility

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As the board considers the eligibility of a certain town employee for retroactive premium pay authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act, the regulations issued by the Treasury Department should be considered first. Section 603C)(1)(B) of the Act provides as follows:

- B. Premium Pay

"Fiscal Recovery Funds payments may be used by recipients to provide premium pay to eligible workers performing essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency or to provide grants to third-party employers with eligible workers performing essential work. These are workers who have been and continue to be relied on to maintain continuity of operations of essential critical infrastructure sectors, including those who are critical to protecting the health and wellbeing of their communities."

Additionally, "...the interim final rule defines essential work as work involving regular in-person interactions or regular physical handling of items that were handled by others. A worker would not be engaged in essential work and, accordingly, may not receive premium pay, for telework performed from a residence."
