1. Erect ladders, staging, and applicable exterior property protection materials and equipment.
  2. Removal to include:
    - a. Up to two rows of slate tiles above the 18' gutter length
    - b. All applicable slate tiles to access the copper shelf, valley, and ridge cap
    - c. One copper downspout
    - d. Copper gutters
    - e. Copper "shelf"
    - f. Copper valley flashing
    - g. Copper ridge cap flashing
  3. Excludes removal of the wood eave trim that the copper gutter rests upon, and decorative dentil molding at the eave/soffit location. If rot is discovered, these details are to be addressed as needed only for an extra cost.
  4. Cover the exposed roof where slate tiles were removed in new high temperature leak barrier membrane.
  5. Fabricate and install new 5" K style copper gutter inclusive of accessory products (end caps, outlets, roof straps, etc.).
  6. Fabricate and install new 2" x 3" square style copper downspout inclusive of accessory products (pipe straps, offset elbows, etc.).
  7. Fabricate and install new 12" x 5' copper shelf on the eave side of the front entry gable.
  8. Fabricate and install new 6' copper valley flashing on the right side of the front entry gable roof.




1. Slate repair work:
  - a. Load materials and equipment and mobilize to the project location.
  - b. Erect ladders and applicable staging to access the work areas.
  - c. Provide and install up to five replacement slate tiles.
  - d. Provide and install compatible copper flashing bibs in conjunction with replacement slate tiles.







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## SCOPE OF WORK

2. Copper gutter repair work (to be performed in conjunction with slate repair work):
  - a. Stage ladders at each gutter location.
  - b. Visually assess each section of gutter.
  - c. Repair fastener pops through the bottom of the gutter troughs on the rear left gutter section.
  - d. Repair pin holes in solder at the bottom of the valley to gutter interface on the front left gutter section.
  - e. Apply compatible Eternabond copper flashing membrane within inner gutter troughs as needed.
  - f. Apply compatible silicone sealant as needed.

3. Copper downspout replacement work:

- a. Remove applicable gutter downspout.
- b. Remove applicable elbow joints (4 per downspout).
- c. Remove and replace outlet at the top of the downspout section as needed.
- d. Fabricate and install twenty-ounce copper elbow offsets at the top of the downspout location.
- e. Fabricate and install twenty-ounce copper downspouts:
  - 2" x 3" smooth rectangular style.
  - Includes replacement downspout clips secured to the masonry walls.
  - Replacement downspouts are to terminate within the cast iron drainpipes at the bottom of the applicable location.
  - Concrete within the cast iron drainpipes to be addressed by others.

### *A Very Grateful Brady Family*

On Thursday November 18<sup>th</sup> the Candia Police Department responded to a frantic emergency call from the Candia House of Pizza. They were faced with a choking infant who had a blocked airway and couldn't breathe.

When Lieutenant Richard Langlois arrived on the scene, he knew every second counted for this child. Without hesitation he sprang into action and began to perform life safety measures to attempt to clear the infant's airway. When the sound of a cry finally echoed out, we knew the airway was partially cleared. This allowed the necessary time needed for transportation to the emergency department.

This Christmas we are extra grateful that the Candia Police Department is just a few steps away from the Candia House of Pizza. We appreciate that you are always there protecting our community day and night. Lieutenant Richard Langlois, thank you for being our hero and for your dedication to serve others. We wish all of you a very Merry Christmas and truly appreciate all that you do!

## SAFETY COMPLEX OBJECTIONS AND QUESTIONS

1. Candia has made great strides forward in 2021 with the appointment of a town administrator. The funding for that position, both next year and importantly, in subsequent years, depends on voter approval of the operating budget in March. Once that operating budget is approved, funding for the town administrator will be embedded in future default budgets and both the town and the incumbent administrator can be assured of future funding for that position. That is why this year is so important.

In addition to asking for approval of a town operating budget that represents a 6% increase over the previous year, the voters will be asked by the Candia School District to approve a multi-year contract for Moore School building repairs and upgrades. The sum total of this contract is \$2.262 million with annual payments of \$192,128 for the next 15 years. In an economy experiencing the worst inflation in 39 years, an increase in property taxes attributable to this contract and an increased operating budget is certain to be of concern with many of the voters. The more we load the 2022 budget, including with this warrant article we are now considering, the greater we risk a default budget for the town.

2. For the above stated reasons, I cannot support a warrant article seeking immediate approval for the acquisition of land and the engineering studies that will be the first step towards a \$ 4 million project in a subsequent year. Both the warrant article itself and the operating budget for 2022 are jeopardized once the residents understand that a \$4 million police facility project is the next step.

3. An even worse case, however, is if the voters don't do the math in March and approve the warrant article for the acquisition of the land and subsequent engineering studies but when presented with nearly a \$4 million warrant article to finance a police facility with borrowed money in a subsequent year, they blink and reject a \$4 million police facility. By then the town will then have spent \$644,580. It will own the land for \$400,000 but little else of immediate value until the warrant article is brought forward again and passes.

4. Allow me to summarize my argument.

- This is not the year to propose both the acquisition of the land for a public safety complex and an additional \$244,580 for the design and engineering of a safety facility. Public support for a project of this magnitude, nearly \$4 million, has not been determined yet it is vitally important when funding for the actual construction is presented in the future. I remind you that 2/3 of the voters must be persuaded to support a bond issue should that method of financing be decided. A simple warrant article proposing the purchase just the land is a practically risk free way to assess public support and would have less than \$.20 impact on the tax rate.
- The voters, on the same day they will consider this warrant article, will also consider a school district warrant article that will commit Candia to paying \$192,218 for each of the next 15 years.
- These two warrant article alone totaling nearly \$537,000, if approved, will increase the tax rate by \$1.02, or 5% in 2022.

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- Finally, and most importantly for the success our proposed budget for next year: The town operating budget exceeds the default budget by over \$220,000 in an era threatened by a pandemic and the uncertainty of the worst inflation in 39 years. This is the year to protect and maintain the progress we have made by defending our operating budget and asking for no more than only the purchase of land for the safety complex.
