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1 UNAPPROVED 2 Candia's Virtual Selectmen's Public Session Minutes 3 April 11th, 2022. at 7:00 pm 4 5 Note: Individual roll call has been taken after each motion. 6 7 7:10 pm Chair Brock opened the Public Session Meeting followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. 8 Attendance: Chair Brien Brock, Selectmen Patrick Moran, Selectman Russ Dann, Selectman 9 Boyd Chivers, Selectman Sue Young and Town Administrator Andria Hansen. 10 11 Approval of Minutes: Public Session Minutes for March 28th, 2022. 12 MOTION: Selectman Dann made a motion to accept the March 28th, 2022, Public Session 13 minutes as amended. Seconded for discussion by Selectman Young. Discussion Opened, 14 Selectman Young corrected line 23 to, limits it to a single dwelling. Line 147 to replace, "Many 15 people said they disagree" to "Two male Selectmen disagreed". There was a conversation on 16 whether or not to add the zoom chat comments to the minutes. No decision was made to include 17 chat comments into the minutes. The subject was brought up if the minutes should be brief or more 18 detailed. No decision was made. Discussion ended. 19 MOTION: Selectman Chivers made a motion to accept the March 28th, 2022, Public Session 20 minutes as presented. Discussion Opened, Selectman Chivers stated the changes on line 23 to 21 Selectman Young suggested. Selectman Young disagreed and wanted to strike out line 147 and to 22 make it accurate and read "Two male Selectmen disagreed". Selectman Chivers moved to include 23 line 147 with the amendment to the minutes. Discussion ended. Seconded by Selectman Moran. 24 25 All in favor. Motion carried by a vote of 5-0-0. 26 27 Department Reports: Highway; Police; Fire; Building; Solid Waste; Budget; Other. 28 Highway: Road Agent Jeff Wuebbolt read the attached report and gave an update. Chair Brock 29 reminded the Road Agent to repair the two radiuses at the Town Hall parking lot and the shoulders 30 31 on Chester Turnpike. 32 Police: Chief Mike McGillen read the attached report and gave an update. Drug Take Back will 33 be held on April 30th from 10am-2pm at Candia's Fire Station. The new police cruiser might be in 34 later this week, it will need to have equipment installed and it could possibly be ready to operate 35 in a few weeks. 36 37 Fire: Selectman Chivers read the attached reports. Fire Chief Young gave an update about the 38 quick response time with Candia's ambulance and the hiring of additional staffing, and that it is 39 all working out well. He will be adding the number of response calls to his reports. He mentioned 40

that they are working on selling one of their Fire Engine Trucks through a Broker.
