Dear Chief McGillen & Mr. Brock,

I am writing on behalf of the Candia Fire Department to request that the Candia Police Department and Candia Board of Selectmen consider reallocating the Ford Explorer police vehicle that is being replaced in 2024. While there may be other interest in replacing the animal control officer or building inspector vehicles, we believe the benefits of transferring the vehicle to the fire department this year is extremely important and can provide significant cost savings to the fire and ambulance budgets.

The fire department does not have any staff vehicles to utilize for its non-emergency operations. We are often asked to go to people's residences to change smoke detectors or help with non-emergency needs. We travel to area hospitals to obtain medications or equipment outside of ambulance patient transport. We have meeting requirements at area departments, local hospitals, or the fire academy in Concord. Members must either drive their personal vehicles, without reimbursement, or take a department vehicle. This puts increased milage and wear on fire engines and ambulance with replacement costs of \$1 million and \$400,000 respectively, as well as adding to their significantly higher maintenance and fuel costs as compared to a standard vehicle. It also puts a fire engine or ambulance out of its coverage area. For example, in November the ambulance transported to Exeter Hospital and needed to go to Elliot for medication restock. While the ambulance was at the hospital, a medical call in Candia occurred. This delayed the ambulance response. Whereas, if a vehicle like this SUV was available, one member could drive there and the other could stay in town with the ambulance.

The use of the vehicle will reduce the use of emergency vehicles for non-emergency calls for service and daily operations. It can also be used to allow members to attend trainings outside of Candia without putting unreimbursed miles on their own vehicles. The vehicle can also be utilized to assist in the transport of members to and from emergency scenes in and around Candia. It can further be used a command vehicle for large scale events which all area departments already have. This vehicle is ready for our use as it is set up with the necessary equipment for the fire department to easily transition into our operations.

This vehicle would last at the fire department for years to come, saving the town thousands of dollars in fuel and mileage/usage of our expensive emergency vehicles. We hope you consider this option as we see this is a great asset for the department and the town. <u>Petitioned Warrant Article</u> - In accordance with RSA 39:3, the below Candia registered voters request that the selectmen place the following warrant article on the warrant for the next Town Meeting.

ARTICLE X. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to transfer the management and responsibility for the following town-owned properties to the Candia Conservation Commission, to be held forever in trust for the benefit and enjoyment of the citizens:

2024 IRS Standard Mileage Rate

On December 14, 2023, the IRS announced the standard mileage rate for 2024.

Effective January 1, 2024, the standard mileage rate for the use of a car, van, pickup and panel truck will be <u>67 cents per mile</u>, up 1.5 cents from 65.5 cents in 2023. These rates apply to electric and hybrid-electric automobiles as well as gasoline and diesel-powered vehicles.

Kindly advise as to which rate, 67 cents or 65.5 cents, the Board of Selectmen authorizes for mileage reimbursement to Town employees for the year 2024.
