RSA 289:8 Enforcement (page 69)	
Any person designated as a cemetery trustee falling to comply with the	
provisions of RSA 289:7 shall be guilty of a violation. Any other person who	
violates this chapter or any regulation established under the authority of this chapter shall be guilty of a violation.	
RSA 289:9 Use of Trust Funds (page 69)	
- Cemetery corporations and the trust fund trustees of municipalities may take and hold funds in trust, and may apply the income of the trust to the improvement, watering, or embellishment of the cemetery, or to the care, preservation, or embellishment of any lot or its appurtenances.
