## Candia Recycling & Energy Committee Public Meeting Minutes January 28, 2021

Attendance:

Committee members: Clay Caddy, Russ Dann, Dick Snow, and Al Couch. Gail Thomas attended via zoom. Also in attendance was invited guest Cody Wood. Dick Snow set up the meeting to be available on Zoom.

Cody was invited to the meeting because he had given Russ a sheet describing an idea he had to advertise local businesses. Russ thought the committee should look at the idea, and also invited Cody to attend this meeting for discussion on the idea.

Cody started by saying he had been a resident Candia for a couple of years, and he has a farm on which he grows garlic which he also sells. He had the idea that a side of the storage trailer at the Recycling Center could be used to paint a billboard for his business. That gave him the idea that other small businesses in Candia might also like to use the trailers to get their message across.

There was extensive discussion about the logistics of using the trailer, and how the businesses being advertised would pay for creating the billboard, and compensate for the advertising. Everyone thought the idea was worthy of being looked into some more. We will all try to put together some additional ideas that might make this work. This will be discussed again at a future meeting.

Committee members reviewed a draft of the annual Recycling & Energy Committee report that will go into the Town Report. All agreed that the report was acceptable for submission.

LED street light conversion was discussed. All has contacted several companies that do LED retrofitting of street lights, but has not yet heard from a couple of them. They will be contacted again soon to see if they will be submitting proposals.

Clay said he is in the planning stages of building a shed roof over the oil and electronics storage area. This is another project that has been needed for a long time to help protect the oil tanks, make them easier to use, and protect the recycling materials that are stored there. The project will be initiated in the spring.
