Transportation Survey Results

During March 2016, the Candia Planning Board and Transportation Steering Committee of the Board implemented a Transportation Survey of the Town of Candia. The survey was delivered to all town residents in coordination with the local Boy Scout Troop and posted electronically on the Town website. The purpose of the survey was to obtain input from town residents about the town's transportation needs and road improvements. The survey was completed at the end of March 2016. The following highlights the survey results.

A total of 156 surveys were completed and submitted. This represents roughly 4% of the town's 3,920 residents (2014, OEP Estimate). Each question from the survey is identified below in chronological order. Questions that involved open-responses include a summarized frequency count of the major themes from the responders; the full open answers can be found in the Appendix of this document.
