PRESS RELEASE UPDATE FROM MAY 14th

The owner of the dog involved in the recent complaint is fully cooperating with the investigation being conducted by the New Hampshire Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (NHSPCA) and the Candia Police Department.

The dog is currently in the care and custody of the SPCA and is receiving care.

The dog owner, has voluntarily complied with all requests made by the NHSPCA and relevant authorities. All necessary information has been provided, and the owner is actively supporting efforts to ensure a fair and thorough review of the situation.

The Candia Police Department works closely with the NHSPCA and fully supports their process, We care deeply about the dog's welfare and the safety of the community, and I want to see this matter resolved responsibly.

The NHSPCA is currently evaluating the dog and will determine any next steps based on the findings of their investigation. No further decisions have been made at this time.
