social media, substance abuse, driving, and truancy, as well as how to safely and peacefully interact with peers and police.

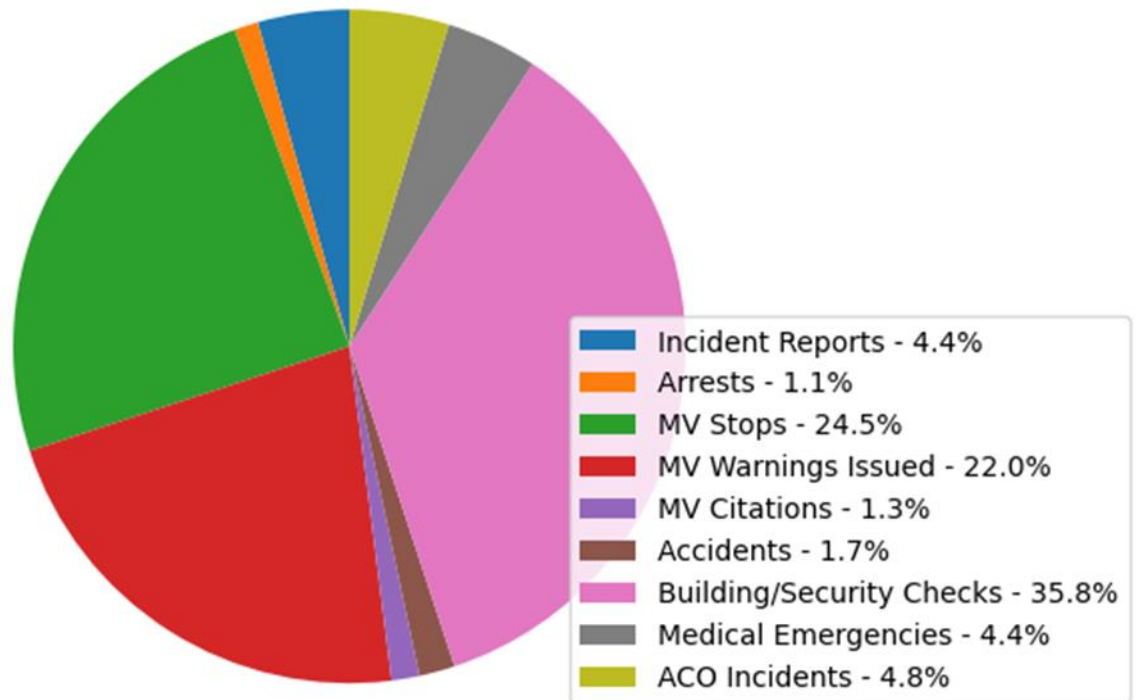

The Candia Police Department wanted to alert residents of a scam from the DMV. If you have received or do receive any text messages like the one below, **please do not click on it, do not pay for it, this is a scam.** The DMV will send out letters/bills if you owe them money.

Department of Motor  
Vehicles (DMV) Final Notice:  
Enforcement Penalties Begin  
on June 4.

Our records indicate that you  
currently have an unpaid  
traffic violation. Pursuant to  
Section 15C-16.003 of the  
U.S. Administrative Code, if  
payment is not received by  
June 4, 2025, the following  
enforcement actions will be  
taken:

1. Report to the DMV violation  
database
2. Suspend your vehicle  
registration starting June 4
3. Suspend driving privileges  
for 30 days
4. Transfer to a toll booth and  
charge a 35% service fee
5. You may be prosecuted  
and your credit score will be  
affected
