UPDATE ON NEW HAMPSHIRE
INSPECTION LAWS SET TO CHANGE
ON 1/31/2026

NEW HAMPSHIRE'S STATE VEHICLE INSPECTION LAW WILL CHANGE ON JANUARY 31, 2026. EVEN AFTER THE CHANGE IT WILL STILL BE ILLEGAL TO DRIVE A VEHICLE THAT IS UNSAFE.

EXAMPLES OF LAWS THAT WILL STILL APPLY:

- *WORKING BRAKES AND LIGHTS, SAFE TIRES (PROPER TREAD) ALONG WITH OTHER ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT WILL STILL BE REQUIRED.
- *UNSAFE CONDITIONS SUCH AS FUEL AND EXHAUST LEAK RULES WILL STILL APPLY.
- *NOISE AND EXHAUST LEVELS FOR BOTH VEHICLES AND MOTORCYCLES WILL STILL APPLY.
- *COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WILL STILL BE REQUIRED TO BE INSPECTED.
- *SPECIAL RULES WILL APPLY FOR SALVAGE AND ANTIQUE VEHICLES.

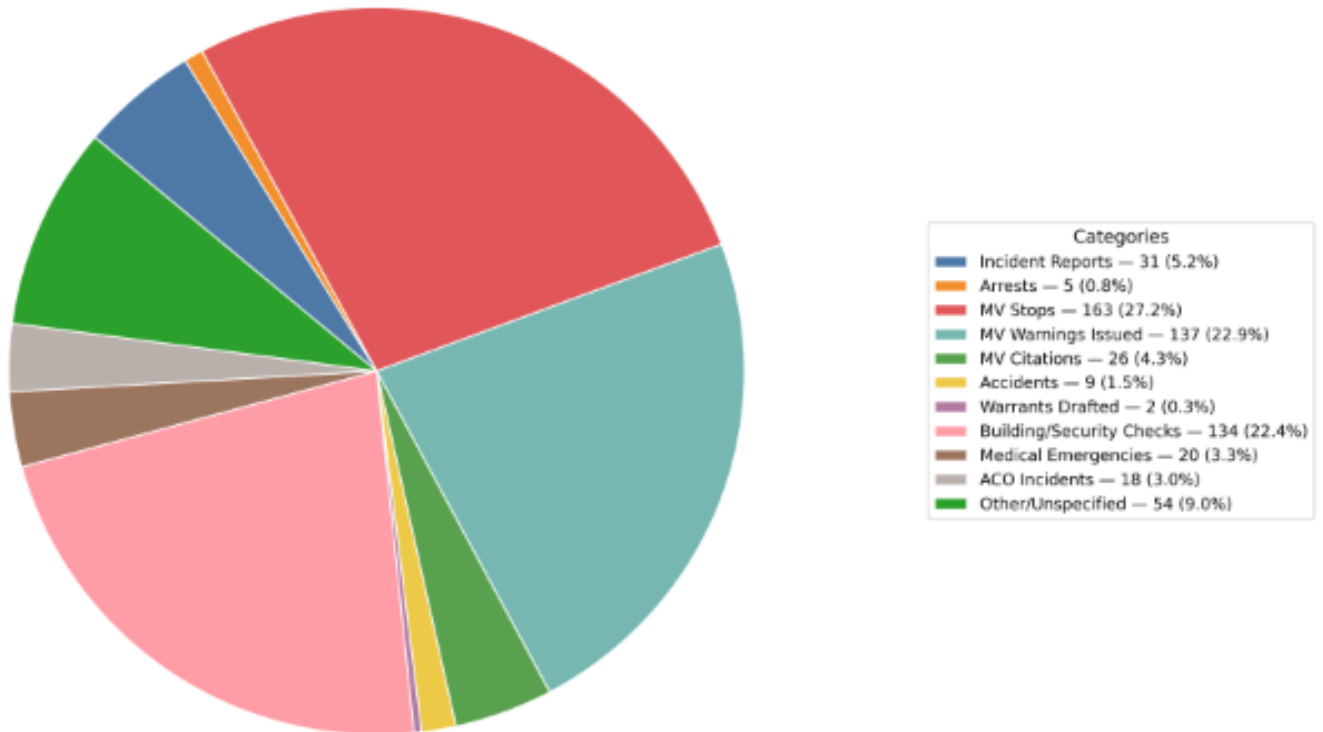
IT IS STILL HIGHLY RECOMMENDED TO HAVE YOUR VEHICLE ROUTINELY CHECKED OUT BY A QUALIFIED MECHANIC TO ENSURE SAFE OPERATION.

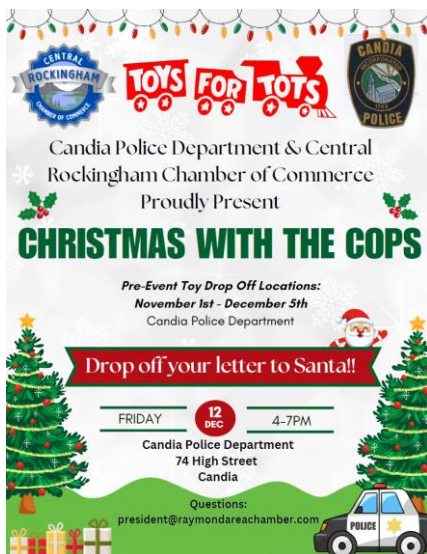
